Our Elephant room, is led by team leader Maria. She is supported by a great team of Nursery Nurses on a Child : Nursery Nurse ratio of 1:4.

Elephant room caters for toddlers age 2 to 2 ½ years old.

Key Worker

Your child will be allocated a key-worker, however all Nursery Nurses will engage and interact with your child whilst in their care.

Activities

The team leader will plan a range of interactive and engaging activities each week and monitor progress and development through ongoing observations during play.

A development profile will be filled out throughout their time at nursery and a log of their activities will be uploaded to your child's online Parenta Dayshare account. A Room Report will be written on each room transition throughout their time at nursery.

We have an open door policy, if you have any concerns or queries regarding your child, please speak to a member of the team.

Nappy Changes/Potty Training

Elephant Room use the changing facilities, toilets and potties in the upstairs toilets.

Please send in all nappy changing requirements you wish for your child to use, (nappies, wipes, cream etc) and ensure a supply of nappies, wipes and spare clothes are replenished each time your child attends nursery.

We will work with you and encourage your little one when potty training. Please remember spare clothes and wipes in case of accidents.

Sleep Time

Elephant room have padded sleep mats which are brought out at sleep time. Each child has their own bedding which is kept in a name-labelled bag. We will follow your toddler's routine and encourage sleep if and when required.

Meal Times

Elephant room have their breakfast and snack and tea in their room, and their lunch in the dining hall. They are encouraged to sit at the table and feed themselves, with support when needed.

Parenta App Communication

We will communicate your child's day through the Parenta app. You will be able to read about all of the important parts of their day such as nappy changing, feeding and sleeping, not to mention letting you know about the exciting learning they have experienced. Where possible, photos of your child will also be sent.

Outdoor Play

Outdoor play is incorporated into the daily routine, Elephant children enjoy using the park and the outdoor classroom in the bark area. Some activities are weather permitting, so please ensure your child comes to nursery with appropriate clothing, e.g. sun hats, wellies and a coat. We have all weather all in one suits at nursery that are used. During the sunny months we also ask you to provide sun cream and hats.
